# What are your kids going to do this summer?



In today's world of working parents figuring out something fun for your child is hard, especially if they are 6-14 years old. Daycare is set up for younger children, but kids in the 6-14 year age group need stimulating activities that can help them burn off energy. Quest Summer Day Camp offers a positive summer alternative to families that includes active learning and

recreational experiences in the course of 10 weeks throughout the summer. We understand that kids need positive role models in the summer, and we offer chances to interact with great staff!

Quest is located on ten acres in beautiful Coeur d'Alene Idaho at the CDA Church of the Nazarene. This is the 20<sup>th</sup> summer of Quest. We are open Monday-Friday 9am-3pm beginning June 13<sup>th</sup> and ending August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2016. Optional Extended care is for 8-12 year olds, hours are 7-9am and 3-6pm. Each week's activities are planned and focused around a theme. Some activities are just for fun. Other activities are about serving our community through life learning experiences.

Some of our field trips offer food for purchase. On these days, children can bring money if they choose to purchase food for lunch or snacks. Pancakes are offered Wednesday mornings till 9am for \$1. Pizza is usually every Thursday for lunch. The cost is \$1 per slice. Money is collected for both of these at check in.
